Transfer Station Sticker Waiver Form

Under the Town of Hanson Transfer Station regulations effective September 1, 2011, this form is provided to residents requesting a waiver or other special provision beyond the scope of the Transfer Station regulations. This form requires review and approval by the Board of Health **PRIOR TO** an applicant making application for a Transfer Station sticker.

All applicants must be an Eligible Person as defined by the Town of Hanson Transfer Station Regulations which is a year-round resident or tenant of Hanson of a residential dwelling in the Town of Hanson. Please indicate the type of waiver being requested under this application and provide all necessary supporting documentation (copies of registrations, driver's license, tax bills, etc.) to assist the Board of Health in making a determination. The Board of Health may request additional information as needed.

- Military Waiver** – an applicant's primary residence is in Hanson and vehicle is registered in another community (either in-state or out-of-state). Proof of active duty must be submitted as part of this application and will be kept on file with the Town of Hanson.
- Town Line Waiver** - a resident owning property in Hanson and an adjacent municipality which is bisected by a Town line and vehicle registration and/or driver's license indicates residency in a town other than Hanson. As a minimum, applicants must provide evidence that taxes are paid in the Town of Hanson.
- Commercial Registration/Plate Waiver** – all applicants with commercial plates must provide proof that the vehicle will not be used to transport commercial waste. The applicant must be an eligible person; the vehicle may only be used by the eligible person; the applicant must attest that he/she has no other method to transport waste from his/her Hanson residence and the applicant must further attest in writing that he/she will not dispose of commercial waste at the Hanson Transfer Station and will only dispose of waste from their own residential household in Hanson.
- Special Circumstances Waiver** – On a separate sheet of paper, please provide a written description of the nature of the request you are seeking. Individual requests of this type will be reviewed by the Board of Health on a case-by-case basis and may be conditional.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Town of Hanson Transfer Station Regulations, any permit may be suspended, modified or revoked by the Board of Health (or designee) upon receipt of evidence satisfactory to the Board that the permittee has not conformed to the requirements of the "Rules and Guidelines of the Hanson Transfer Station" or such further regulations as may be adopted or to any applicable state or Federal statute, regulation, rule or order regarding recycling and the or disposal of solid waste.
