NEW BUSINESS

I. New Business:

- (1) Reorganization – Mr. Perkins made a motion to nominate Ms. Pinnetti chair, Mr. Perkins Vice Chair, Ms. Dias Member – Motion did not carry. Ms. Dias made a motion to nominate herself as chair, 2nd by Ms. Pinnetti, Mr. Perkins voted No. Ms. Dias made a motion to nominate Ms. Pinnetti as Vice Chair, 2nd by Ms. Pinnetti., Mr. Perkins voted yes 3-0
- (2) Approve BOH Minutes for May 10 2022, – Ms. Pinnetti made a motion to approve the BOH minutes for May 10, 2022, 2nd by Mr. Perkins 3-0
- (3) Map 1, Lot 1282 Snow Street – Ms. Pinnetti made a motion that any plan that has expired after 3 years must submit a new application and fee. Ms. Dias via the rule of necessity voted yes, Mr. Perkins abstained. 2-0-1.
- (4) Transfer Station Policies & Procedures – Ms. Dias asked the Board if they thought signs regarding social distancing were needed. There was an incident at the TS regarding distancing between residents offloading trash/recycling. The Health Agent will look into if there is any policy or procedure for this.
- (5) FY 2023 Budget – tabled until next meeting
- (6) Septic Plans
 - 159 Pierce Ave** – 3 Bedroom – Mr. Perkins made a motion to allow for the following variance, 2nd by Ms. Pinnetti. 3-0.
 - a. To allow a vertical separation reduction from the proposed SAS to be 3” instead of the required 4’ from mottling.
 - b. To allow the use of a grain size distribution analysis to establish loading rate.
 - 447 Holmes Street.** – 3 Bedroom – Mr. Perkins made a motion to allow for the following variance, 2nd by Ms. Pinnetti. 3-0. Conditional on the inverts on the tanks be sealed with hydraulic cement at time of install or rubber boots on tank.
 - a. To allow the use of a grain size distribution analysis to establish loading rate.
 - b. To allow the inlets of the septic tank and pump chamber to be less than 1’ above soil mottling.
