This hearing was continued from 8/17/19. Mr. Rogers submitted revised plans dated 9/18/19 that depicted adjustments to the flagging that were suggested by the Commission's consultant, Steve Ivas. The Commission was also in receipt of a letter from Brad Holmes, dated 9/19/19 with an explanation of the revised flags and the backup data requested at the last meeting. Mr. Ivas had reviewed the additional information and recommended approval with conditions. Mr. Clemons asked for comments from the abutters. Those present were:

Mrs. Janet Warren: Part of the process is to ask permission to conduct perc tests. Will they be able to fill that area if approved? She was also concerned with them cutting down trees to access the site.

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Mr. Clemons said that there is nothing on the plan to that effect and it would be incumbent upon the applicant to explain how they would do that as it would be an impact. He added that would have to be addressed in a future Notice of Intent.

Mr. Joe Warren: What is the elevation from the street. Was concerned with heavy equipment going through that area as it's very wet.

Mr. Rogers answered that it's about an 8' drop from the street. It's a very heavily wooded area, but they could get a rubber tracked machine in on rubber mats without knocking down a lot of trees.

Mr. Clemons said that the Commission would need a detailed plan for a wetland crossing but tonight, the only thing that they're prepared to act on is the resource area delineation.

Ms. Jean Dean: 15 years ago, she had the wetlands delineated and applied for a shed. She was denied a permit. They have a drainage issue in this area. She doesn't understand how they're allowed to do this.

Mr. Schellenger commented that a Notice of Intent would have to be comprehensive, have a replication plan, show drainage and adhere to the 50' No Disturb Zone.
