Freshwater Mussel Survey

Agent Schellenger stated that freshwater mussels are an endangered species, and, any pond treatments will need to be modified accordingly. He would like the Commission to consider requesting the Board of Selectmen approval for a freshwater mussel survey since it is a Selectmen controlled article.

Ethan Nadeau, Biodrawversity, submitted a proposal for a freshwater mussel survey which would include Indian Head Pond, Wampatuck Pond, and Maquan Pond, to document the presence, abundance, recruitment, and habitat use of state-listed mussels, and to recommend strategies for long-term protection of freshwater mussel communities. The fieldwork would be early spring before algae and aquatic plants flourish and impede visibility. A report to be submitted July 1, 2022. The cost would be \$3,200.00.
