- Installation of 4 observation wells located in the buffer zone. The Water Department will reach out to residents
 in that area with well water to see if they can obtain access. There will also be 5 piezometers installed manually
 and 3 staff gauges to intermittent streams. Tripod insertions can be used if needed.
- 2. The test itself. Also included would be water level monitoring.
- 3. Stepped drawdown test. Increasing pump rate to see the short term effect.
- 4. Turning off pumps and recover ratings.

Mr. Clemons asked the timing on this project. Mr. Martin said it is geared sometime in March.
