Mowing Guidelines for the Meadows

1. Mowing should be done between September 15th and May 15th.

2. Mowing should be done from the "inside" to "outside".

3. Blade height between 8" and 10".

4. For Butterfly habitat: leave some areas (e.g. milkweed) un-mowed. These areas can be varied year to year. Manage

some perimeter areas as "hedgerows".

5. Frequency of mowing: every 1-2 years. Control of forbs, trees, and woody plants may require more frequent or earlier

mowing. In general mow to the wood line to control.

6. For ground bird habitat cut material should be collected every 2-3 years.

7. Maintain close mowed perimeter trails. Post meadows during nesting season (May to September). No pedestrian or

pet travel within the meadow and dogs must be leashed at all times.

Blind & Stand Regulations

Mass. Dept. of Fisheries and Wildlife

Hunters must mark stands and blinds with their permit number. Hunters must remove all stands and blinds within 30 days after the end of the permitted season. One non-hunting companion may accompany each permitted hunter. We

prohibit non-hunting companions from hunting, but they can assist in other means.

Written permission of the landowner (on either public or private lands) is required to construct or use any tree stand which is fastened to a tree by nails, bolts, wire, or other fasteners that intrude through the bark into the wood of the tree, or that is fastened or erected in any manner and is emplaced for a period exceeding 30 days. This includes hang-

on tree stands.
