## Review of Revised 2016 Budget

Selectman McGahan noted that the language in the explanation for STM Article #5 has been revised to include the details of the planned testing study for Wampatuck Pond. He also mentioned that a confirmed quote of \$7,290 was received.

A timeline of changes made to ATM Article 9 for \$176,000 was presented to the Finance Committee noting that the omission of \$80,000 for the fire alarm and smoke detectors for Indian Head and Middle Schools has not been made by Capital Improvements.

Article 5 - Not Recommend Wampatuck Pond Study - \$10,000 - 4-0
Article 7 - Not Recommend Drop Box - \$3,000 - 5-0
Article 12 - Not Recommend, Interior Fire Station, Liberty Street - \$17,000 - 5-0

Amend Article 13 from \$25,000 to \$12,000 - add to Stabilization - 5-0

The above recommendations were made to provide non-borrowed funding source for fire alarms at Indian Head and Hanson Middle resulting in \$43,000 of Free Cash plus \$37,000 budget adjustments to fund from existing levy base.
