Submitting a Septic Plan for Approval

When submitting a Septic Plan for approval please provide the following:

- Application for Disposal Works Construction
- 4 sets of plans, all must have engineer's signature, engineer's stamp, one with the engineer's wet stamp.
- All soil information
- Any Conservation filings
- Fee

Once all items are submitted, it is forwarded to our outside consultant. The plans will be reviewed and returned to the BOH. If changes need to be made, the review sheet will be forwarded to you for plan revisions. Four new sets of stamped plans and resubmission fee need to be submitted with requested changes. Fees for submission are as follows:

Disposal Works Construction Permit

Residential - Up to 2,000 gpd	\$200
Residential - 2,000 – 5,000 gpd	\$325 + outside review fee
Residential - 5,000 – 10,000 gpd	\$500 + " " "
Residential - 10,000 + gpd	\$800 + " " "
Business - 2,000 – 5,000 gpd	\$250 + outside review fee
Business - 5,000+ gpd	\$300 + " " "
Re-submission of septic plans	\$25 (if in house review) <i>or</i> Cost (if required to send out for Engineer's review)
Septic Component Replacement	\$100

If a variance is requested, the plan will be placed on the meeting agenda and go before the Board for review and approval. If no variance is request, the Health Agent will review and approve the plan.

Please Note: Once all items have been submitted, the BOH has 45 days from that date, to approve plans.
