Review Wage & Compensation Matrix

At 6:30 p.m., Wage & Personnel Board Chairman Matt Dyer called the meeting to order.

Interim Town Administrator Meredith Marini explained that this is the Wage & Personnel Board's annual hearing to review departmental amendments and requests for non-union employees. Departments were duly notified on December 4, 2019.

Ms. Marini provided the Board with the current classification and compensation plan as well as the recommended plan with proposed changes to be approved at the Annual Town Meeting in May, and taking effect on July 1, 2020. Most of the changes to the plan would be to adjust the pay ranges for the positions with a starting rate \$12.00 per hour to the new minimum wage of \$12.75 per hour. Also, the Town Clerk has requested that top of the range for Election Workers, Election Officers, Election Warden and Registrars of Voters be increased from \$15.00 per hour to \$16.75 per hour.
