October 2, 2021 Event

We named the event "Old Home Day"

Bob Perkins from North American Amusement presented information for a possible Carnival for October 2nd.

They offer 5-hour rentals. Rentals include set-up and take down, Insurance, experienced & CORI'd employees to run/man the rides.

He offered 7 different rides including the Popcorn & Cotton Candy trailer. It also includes tickets to use and a ticket booth.

He spoke about safety of the rides, the registration process of rides.

He would like to set-up the Swing on Friday and then would come the following morning to set up the rest of the rides.

It was discussed to offer this Carnival as a free event for the town. However, Mr. Perkins strongly advised against this. We agreed that it would be very difficult to accept cash for tickets. We will check with Lisa Green to see if we can have a non-profit agency collect and keep the money from ticket sales.

Parade portion was discussed:

Audrey spoke with Chief Miksch regarding the parade. He was concerned with his budget. We will investigate whether we can pay for the police details from our budget. He was however 100% supportive of the parade and event and said he will make it work no matter what.
