3. Wind River has been submitting incomplete Title V reports for several months. They have been contacted via e-mail, telephone & Certified Mail, with no response. Their permit expired on December 31, 2017. The Board is requiring that they come before the Board at the next meeting to explain why they are not in compliance with the Towns Title V Supplemental Regulations. They will be unable to conduct any Title V inspections until such time as the Board issues them a valid Title V inspectors permit. Should they choose not to appear, they will not be granted a permit.

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4. Horse Permit - 23 Monroe - The Board agreed to renew the horse permit for Ms. Curran. The permit is for her current 2 horses and 1 pony only. The renewal is granted with the knowledge that it will only be valid for her originally permitted horses. Once the current horses/pony pass away she will be unable to obtain another permit with new horses, due to land constraints.

Horse Permit - 122 Indian Head - The Board agreed to renew the horse permit for 2 horses. Mr. Boyle is also requesting to have a 3rd horse. The Board declined due to land constraints. Mr. Amado made a motion to approve Horse Permit renewals for the above listed properties, 2nd by Ms. Dias. 2-0
