Agent Schellenger discussed the MACC notice and stated that Keolis does not agree with it. He spoke with Matt Donovan from FDC Engineering, and Mr. Donovan believes this can be approved. Agent Schellenger said he is not happy with the response received and has reached out to the Circuit Rider at MA DEP for a response. The MACC opinion states that if the RDA includes vegetation cutting, the Commission should not approve the request. The MBTA has approached the MA DEP to have the regulation wording changed. Agent Schellenger invites the Commission to read both letters before the next meeting.

Agent Schellenger asked if the plan has been cleared with the Highway Department because it is usually not allowed to tie into the MS4.

Chair Clemons requested that Mr. Burch contact the Highway Department in case there are any issues regarding the MS4 and also send an email along with the request to continue hearing to the next Conservation Commission Meeting, November, 18, 2020.
