7:00 PM Request for Determination of Applicability to construct required service line to install town water on the long driveway which crosses a bordering vegetated wetland which lies along a small, east-flowing perennial stream that is tributary to Indian Head Brook at 824 East Washington Street, Map 113, Lot 6A, Key 2 for Laura Salonga.

Request for Minor Modification to the Order of Conditions for Stephen Bryant, Eversource, Map 106, Lot 11 at Whitman and Winter Street, SWCA Project: 67457 (DEP# SE175-0684) – requires vote

Eversource has requested to waive the installation of the proposed 1,000-gallong roof dry well system (drainage) to the existing plans for the gas regulator station project. The dry well system will serve no purpose in location with the surrounding site conditions. The final surface of the entire driveway and area directly surrounding the regulator station will consist of 1-2" gravel stone at a depth of approximately 8" laid over filter fabric, allowing for stormwater from the roof to be managed naturally through a semi pervious surface resulting in no overland flow from the roof runoff. It will also reduce the permanent fill/impacts to the 100' buffer zone to associated bordering vegetated wetland.

Cranberry Cove

Concerns regarding Cranberry Cove. There was a proposal forwarded to Recreation Commission in March 2022 from Chessia Consulting LLC to prepare a plan for managing stormwater at Cranberry Cove and the adjacent driveway of Camp Kiwanee. Conservation Commission to repeat recommendation to Selectboard summarizing recommended actions. The deterioration will continue, to the detriment of public recreational interests and our natural resources, until the stormwater runoff problems are resolved. Since these resources are subject to Wetland Protection Act regulations, hence the Commission concern.

Motion to prepare letter to Selectboard summarizing recommended actions for Cranberry Cove pointing out that Stormwater runoff has repeatedly caused damage to the parking lot, flooding of the bathhouse, and erosion of the beach sand, including that damage has negatively impacted Maquan Pond and the brook that outlets from the pond.
