Mission

The mission of the Economic Development Commission is to enhance the existing business community, attract new business, attract new customers, and encourage redevelopment and new development as may be advisable in order to increase the Town's property tax revenues, income, job base, and overall economic health.

The Commission will provide the Board of Selectmen and Planning Board with an overview of its activities as well as any recommendations for any changes to the Master Plan, or Bylaws of the Town. The Commission shall also seek the input of the Planning Board on any of its initiatives which impact the planning of the future physical development of the town and/or which relate to new development projects. Further, the Commission will work to identify any grants or awards that would support its mission.

MOTION by FitzGerald-Kemmett, second by Howard to create an Ad-Hoc Economic Development Commission, appointed by the Board of Selectmen to three-year staggered terms; to be comprised of the following members – One member of the Board of Selectmen, one member of the Planning Board, one member of the Hanson business community, and two members of the public at large. The Town Administrator shall serve as an ex-officio non-voting member who may at his discretion designate other member of professional staff to assist the Commission as needed. **Voted 4 – 0**
