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A meeting of the Highway Building Committee was called to order by Chairman William Scott at 5:40 pm on June 13, 2016 at the Highway Department Office.

General Discussion:

With cost savings in mind the following modifications to the architect's original plans were discussed.

- Building #2 should be relegated to use as an equipment storage area only.
- Salt shed is a must for operational reasons. Footprint of shed is negotiable.
- Extent and quality of building skin replacement.
- Wider doors to reduce grading requirements and associated costs.
- Reduce costs by modifying interior layout.
- Substitute chain link fencing for iron fencing.

Public outreach program to be initiated prior to the October Town Meeting.

Weston & Sampson will make suggested revisions to plan and present it to the committee at our next meeting.
