**New Business**

- Discussion on contract regarding proposal of Day Camp including swim and fitness clinics at Camp Kiwanee with Margaret Cameron-Hickey - Much discussion took place regarding the program and whether the 80/20 split should be based on gross or net revenue. Chairman proposes a two-year contract with net revenue for the first year and gross revenue for the second year. Ms. Hickey should have Board of Health approval in one more week. Ms. Hickey is to have her attorney review the contract. This will be discussed again at the next meeting, May 17, 2021.
- Discussion on proposed swimming lessons at Camp Kiwanee – Emily Hickey provided a very thorough review of her proposed program. Ms. Hickey would not be able to work for less than an hourly wage of \$22.00. Chairman to speak with wage and personnel to see if the current maximum wage of \$20.00 can be increased.

- Discussion on obtaining pest control service – Ehrlich Pest Control at Camp Kiwanee – Motion by Commissioner Brian Fruzzetti to engage in services with Ehrlich Pest Control, and suspend the service in the winter months.

- Discussion on purchasing dumpster enclosure for dumpster at Camp Kiwanee – A quote of \$2,598.59 was received from South East Fence & Supply in Lakeville. Procurement requirements are to use sound business practice (ensuring the receipt of favorable prices by periodically soliciting price lists or quotes.) Commissioner Smith has determined South East Fence & Supply to be very competitive.  
Motion by Commissioner Scartissi to purchase the dumpster from South East Fence & Supply  
Second by Commissioner Brian Fruzzetti  
Voted 7-0
- Discussion on hiring additional caretakers for events at Camp Kiwanee. – With the wedding season approaching it was decided to bring on three or four additional caretakers.
