

Recreation Commission Meeting Minutes

June 18, 2020

4:00 p.m.

Virtual Meeting through Town Hall

Members present: Diane Cohen, Chair; John Zucco, Vice Chair; Brian Fruzzetti, Melissa Scartissi, Joan Fruzzetti, Juvy Hartweg

Also present: Gill Amado, Health Agent; Arlene Dias, Chair, Board of Health; Bill Boyle; Dori Jamieson

Discussion on whether to open Cranberry Cove for the season was discussed.

Recreation Director Boyle provided a thorough synopsis of the process if the cove were to open. Three guards would be necessary and two gate keepers and life jackets would need to be disinfected with bleach and water. Social distancing and face masks must be enforced. Health Agent Amado had concerns with the Governor's order #31 and felt it was not doable. Cleaning the restrooms twice daily thoroughly would be necessary, and having wipes and sanitizer available, and snacks would not be allowed. He had a concern of coming out of the water with 6 feet distancing, and facial coverings would be difficult to manage. Board of Health Chair Dias felt that it was doable, and there is a way to manage and navigate through the order.

Motion by Vice Chair Zucco pending Board of Selectmen approval and water testing results, proper staffing, masks to be worn, not to exceed ten people in a group twelve feet apart and all necessary precautions by the Governor to open the Cove for swimming only, no kayaks, on July 5th through Labor Day from 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. AND 1:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., two shifts. Not to be open when school is in session, to sell \$5.00 day passes through a reservation system.
