Early voting will began on February 24th and will continue through February 28th, 2020 for the Presidential Primary on March 3rd.

Early voting can be done in person at the Hanson Town Hall, 542 Liberty Street during regular business hours, which are Monday, Wednesday and Thursday 8 am – 1 pm, 2 pm - 5 pm; Tuesday, 8 am – 1 pm, 2 pm - 8 pm; and Friday, 8 am – 12 noon. Voting may be done any time during those hours from February 24th – February 28th.

Absentee ballots are now available at the Hanson Town Clerk's office for the Presidential Primary being held on Tuesday, March 3rd. Any registered voter who is unable to vote in person on Election Day due to absence from town, physical disability or religious belief may obtain an absentee ballot. Voters may absentee vote in person at the Town Clerk's office or by mail. Applications for absentee ballots will be accepted at the Town Clerk's office until 12:00Noon Monday, March 2nd. All voters and residents who have not returned their 2020 census form are urged to do so by the Town Clerk. Any voter that has not returned their 2020 town census form will be placed on the inactive voter list for future elections
