

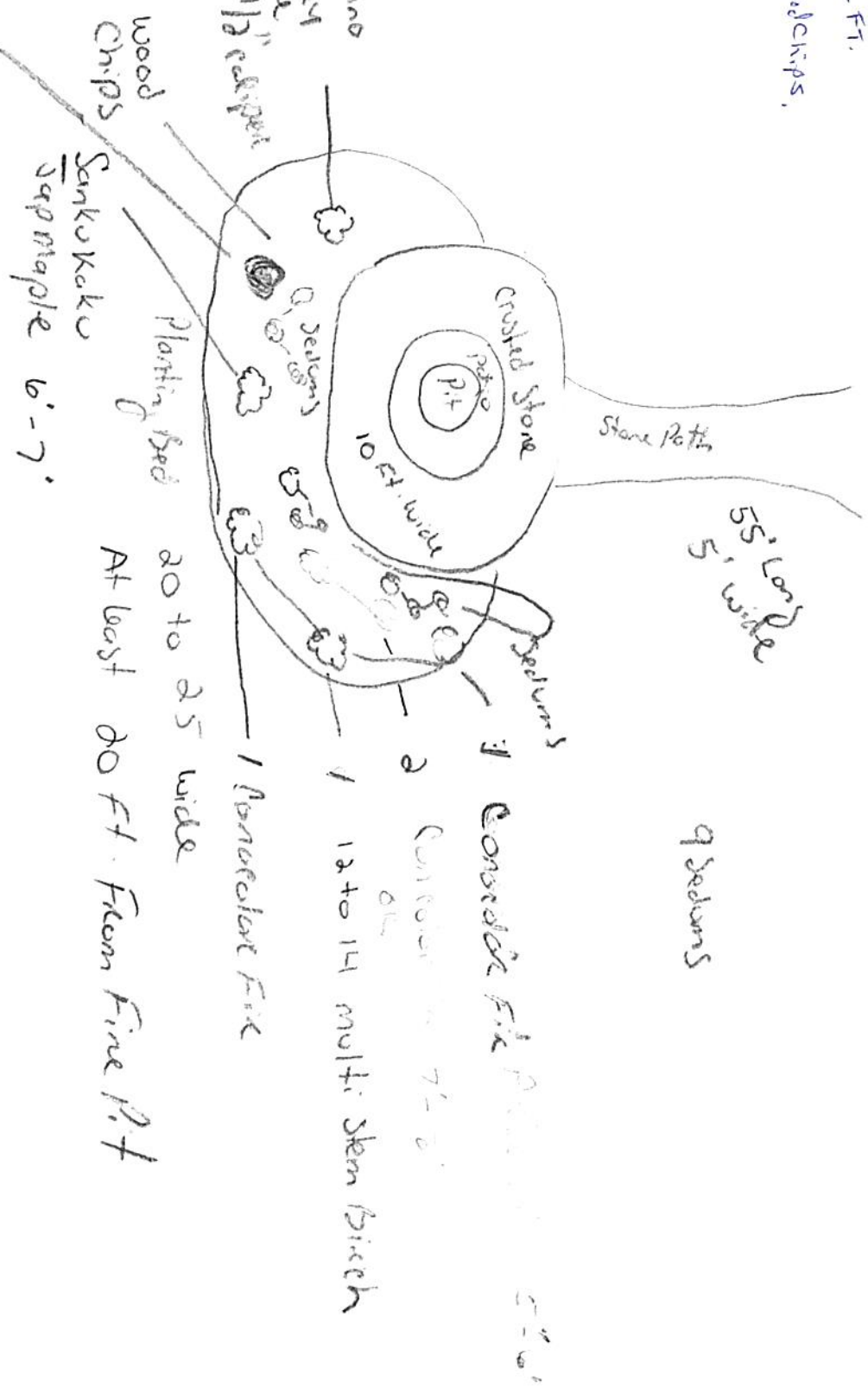

## Snow-in-Summer (Cerastium tomentosum)

Snow-in-summer ground cover looks like flowery snow drifts that can spill over stone walls and landscape. And unlike actual snow, full sun is what helps this plant thrive. The herbaceous perennial blooms profusely in early summer with pristine white flowers. It can be difficult to grow in high heat and humidity, but it's tolerant of drought and shallow, rocky soil.

- **USDA Growing Zones:** 3 to 7
- **Color Varieties:** White flowers
- **Sun Exposure:** Full sun
- **Soil Needs:** Sandy, dry, well-draining



## Heuchera

An evergreen perennial, heuchera is known for its vibrant foliage, which ranges in color from silver to green to brown. The large, veined, heart-shaped leaves have a spread of 18-24



inches, and most varieties bloom in late spring with small pink flowers. When planted in groups, heuchera works well as a ground cover or along garden edging. The plant prefers partial shade or full sun and well-draining moist soil. What's more, it requires relatively little maintenance, and it resists deer and other critters

# Stonecrop

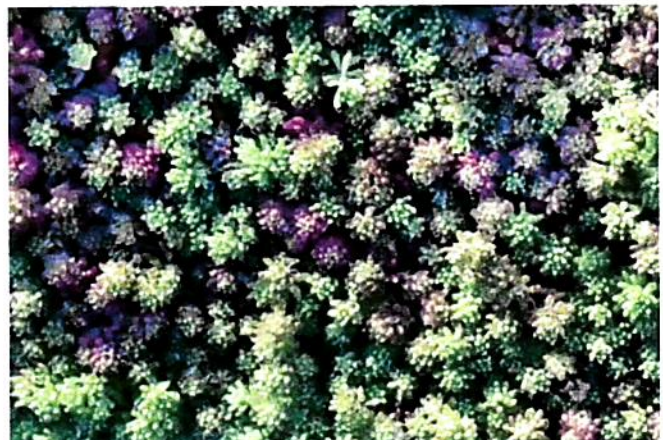

Need an easy, evergreen carpet to plant where no grass dare grow? Though its lush leaves don't scream "drought-tolerant," sedum boasts an ability to root and thrive in even the driest, rockiest settings—thus earning it the familiar name "stonecrop." The secret? Those fleshy, bluish-green leaves help retain what little water it receives. Aid with a little mulching and weeding to prevent unwanted sprouts from stealing water from these low-maintenance succulents, and you can enjoy their cheery color year-round—even starry yellow buds when the plant blooms in spring.



## **CREEPING SEDUM:**

If you have a hot, dry, sunny location, groundcover sedum is a perfect match. Using sedum as a groundcover keeps other plant roots cool, conserves moisture, staves off erosion and establishes very rapidly. Plus, these pleasant little plants offer easy-care appeal and color. If you are a fan of low maintenance plants, continue reading for creeping sedum info. [Creeping Sedum Info](#) Sedum plants come in many shapes and sizes and are prized for their quick establishment and “set it and forget it” nature. While a little bit of care is required



for baby plants, once they have been in site for a couple of months, these charming succulents can mostly be left alone. Rockeries, paths, containers and hilly areas are perfect sites for growing sedum groundcover, one of the lowest forms of the group. Low growing sedum are also referred to as stonecrop, and for good reason. They can literally burst with life even in the cracks of a stone wall. Groundcover sedum comes in varieties with gently rounded leaves tinged in pink to chubby spiky yellow-green foliage. It is these thick leaves that allow sedums to store water and thrive in hot, dry locations. An outstanding surprise and contrast to the interesting leaves are the blooms. Tiny starry flowers in dense, airy clusters come in hues of yellow to pink to rise above the low lying plants, creating drama and a swirl of color.

Hi Dori,

The \$375 Includes a deep floor cleaning service for the floors in the kitchen, we call this a Sani Scrub- Deep tile and grout cleaning.

**The Process:**

1. We apply a safe chemical to the floor.
2. We then go in there with an electric scrubber to loosen up buildup.
3. We use a power washer to rinse and remove any extra build up on the floors.
4. We Lastly use a Machine that will suck up what we just removed to ensure grease, dirt, grime, isn't just moved around- like a typical mop would do.
5. If there is still a layer of build up at the end of these steps, we will then repeat process 1-4.
